Basket Handle

Looking for a cute Easter basket to put sweet treats in? This adorable basket is perfect for display or for tucking goodies in.

**Materials:**

8 ½" x 11" White Card Stock

Scissors

Tape

**Step 1: Print**

Load card stock following printer instructions. (Handle paper by the edges to avoid fingerprints.) Using your ink-jet printer, print the **Easter Basket Template**. (For best results, load only one sheet at a time.) You can substitute regular printer paper for card stock but the basket will not be as sturdy.

**Tips & Tricks:**

- To select the proper print settings in Adobe Acrobat click Print; in the print dialogue box select properties; choose the appropriate paper type; and then select the highest print quality.
- We recommend that you run a test print on regular paper to double-check the layout and design. (If problems occur, check your printer manual for additional printing instructions.)

**Step 2: Dry**

Let paper dry several minutes before handling.

**Step 3: Cut**

Cut around the basket and handle.

**Step 4: Fold**

Fold along the dotted lines of the basket. Once the basket sides have met, secure them on the inside with tape.

Next, take the handle and tape it to the inside of the basket. The handle should be taped to the sides of the basket that do not show the bunny.

**Optional:** Add raffia to the basket or use plastic green grass as a cradle for eggs or candy.
