



Nothing says Easter more than decorating eggs. Set the kids loose and discover the wonderful combinations they create.

Materials:

Egg-Dyeing Kit
Sticker Paper for Ink-Jet Printers
Scissors

Step 1: Print

Load sticker paper into printer. (Handle paper by the edges to avoid fingerprints.) Print **Egg Decorating Template** following manufacturer's instructions. (For best results, load only one sheet at a time.)

**Tips & Tricks:**

- To select the proper print settings in Adobe Acrobat click Print; in the print dialogue box select properties; choose the appropriate paper type; and then select the highest print quality.
- We recommend that you run a test print on regular paper to double-check the layout and design. (If problems occur, check your printer manual for additional printing instructions.)

Step 2: Dry

Let paper dry several minutes before handling.

Optional:**Step 3: Dye eggs**

Following dye manufacturer's instructions, dye the bottom half of the egg.

Step 4: Dry

Let eggs dry for approximately 30 minutes.

Step 5: Cut & Stick

Using scissors cut out the stickers for your eggs. Add the border sticker to cover the seam of the dyed egg. Add additional stickers to the top half of the egg.
